Relaxation of Restrictions


China has been progressively relaxing restrictions on foreign investment since its new Foreign Investment Law took effect in 2020, including removing foreign ownership caps in sectors like life insurance and automobile manufacturing, as well as streamlining investment processes.






Negative List Changing

Foreign Investment Entry System

"Negative List" (Special Administrative Measure for Access of Foreign Investment-2024)

Examples of foreign investment sectors requiring PRC majority stake include

- •Market survey: radio or television rating surveys
- •Basic telecommunication services
- Public air transport company
- •Nuclear power plants construction / Construction or operation of civil airports
- •Education: pre-school institutions, ordinary high school, and institution of higher learning
- Medical institutions

Intellectual Property Rights refers to creations of the mind, such as inventions, literary and artistic works, and designs, as well as symbols, names, and images used in commerce.

- National Registration (China Trademark Office)
- International Registration-WIPO

How long will it take to obtain the copyright registration certificate?

Protection for 10 years and should be renewed





Registration of Patent



Invention – 20 years protection

A product or process that has a practical application

Design – 10 years protection

Visual appearance of a product, such as shape, pattern, or colour of a production or any combination

Utility Model – 10 years protection

For products that have a practical application, but not for processes, chemicals or biotechnology.



Company Law (July 1, 2024)

Provisions of the State Council on Implementing the Registered Capital Registration Management System under the Company Law

Minimum Registered Capital

Paid up within **5 years** from the date of the company's establishment

contribute capital in cash, in kind, or with IPR, land use rights, equity, debt claims, or other non-monetary assets which can be valued in monetary terms and legally transferred
