Rules: Keep your receipts and unused items, and ensure you depart within 90 days of purchase (with final departure within 183 days of your last entry). The tax refund currency is RMB. Refunds over RMB 10,000 require a bank card; for lower amounts, choose between cash or bank transfer.

China runs on mobile apps—don't let weak spotty Wi-Fi connection slows you down! Get Online in 4 Ways:



Roam Freely: Activate international roaming with your current provider, but beware of high costs.



eSIM Magic: Grab a traveler-friendly eSIM online before takeoff (details in the App). Pros: Access to daily social media (Gmail, Facebook, Instagram, TikTok). Cons: No calls or verification codes. Not every smartphone supports eSIM.



Local SIM Savvy: Buy a SIM at arrival airports (find China Mobile/Unicom/Telecom service desks via the app). Short-term SIMs (7/15/30 days) cost 11/16/26 euros respectively for data, texts and calls. Please note, the exact price is subject to change at the time of your card application.



Pocket Wi-Fi: Rent a portable hotspot at Shanghai/Beijing airports—stream, pay, and navigate worry-free (find service desks via the app)! Perfect for families, but remember to keep it on and charge the battery.



QR Code Rulebook


Alipay/WeChat Pay: Link your international card—scan to pay anywhere, from street vendors to luxury malls.

Overseas Cards: Visa, MasterCard, JCB, American Express work in five-star hotels, large malls, duty-free shops etc.

Cash Hacks



Small Bills Matter: Stock up on RMB 1/5/10 notes for vending machines and subways at airport currency exchange counters.

Exchange Wisely: Skip airport counters and self-service machines (high fees!)— opt for better rates at local banks.




Pro tips: Use international bank cards to withdraw cash from ATMs—look for your card network logo for compatibility.

City Walk



iPhone Users: Use built-in maps with roaming or save data with BOC Compass' s offline maps.

Android Users: Rely on BOC Compass' s offline maps for accurate navigation around attractions, commercial centers, and local eateries.

Subway Smarts



QR Codes Rule: Use Alipay/WeChat's Transport feature scan in and out of the station.

Card Swipe: Beijing Subway accepts foreign Visa, MasterCard, and UnionPay cards directly.

No Apps? Buy tickets at machines (cash/card) or grab a rechargeable transport card (Beijing Pass, Shanghai Pass, etc.).

Bike-Sharing Bliss



Scan, ride, repeat! Unlock blue (Hello Bike), yellow (Meituan), or green (DiDi) bikes for RMB 1-2/30 mins. Just park in designated

Ride-Hailing & Taxi



Skip the chaos at airports and train stations by heading to designated taxi queues.

DiDi Dominance: China's Uber alternative! Book taxis, luxury cars, or carpool rides. Pay via Alipay, WeChat, or your international card—no cash needed. Prices are estimated upfront—no language barriers or surprises.



Pro Tip: Pre-book rides during rush hours or rainy days! Always check the car's license plate matches the app's

Real-Name Registration: Use your passport for verification. Seat Upgrades: Splurge on business class for free WiFi, meals, and extra legroom!
